Job Hazard Form

This form highlights hazards related to the role that could pose a risk to the post holder.

Role Title: Caretaker

Manual Handling

This role requires hazardous manual handling operations. For example, regular moving of heavy objects, repetitive moving of objects.

The types of manual handling operation involved in this role are objects.

These manual handling operations are required on a regular basis.

The weights involved in these manual handling operations are 6-10kg.

Work Environment

This role is carried out in an environment which involves frequent lone working and frequent outdoor work.

Work Equipment/Machinery

This role also involves working with hand-held powered tools/hand-guided tool/hand-fed tools.

COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health)

Biological Hazards

It is possible that post holder may come into routine or regular contact with people with infections e.g. human blood or human bodily fluid e.g. soil/waste/ animals/birds

Chemical Hazards

The post holder will come into regular contact with any chemicals such as wood dust, pesticides and oils which may be an irritant.

Applicants should be aware that where roles are exposed to hazardous risks, risk assessments are undertaken and control measures are put into place where possible.
