- 3. Disable search
- 4. Adjust the content level
- 5. Pause watch history
- 6. Add a custom passcode
- 7. Block inappropriate content
- 8. Use restricted mode
- 9. Remove distractions
- 10. Create custom playlists
- 11. Use content filtering
- 12. Have children keep an access or usage reflection journal.
