Belonging, Respect, Responsibility





Our themes this half-term are "Winter wonderland", "Chinese New Year" and "Dinosaurs" **Literacy** – We will continue to learn our phonic sounds, keywords and high frequency words on a daily basis. We will explore fiction and non-fiction books about winter, hedgehogs, dinosaurs, Chinese New Year and being healthy. In our shared reading session we will access digital books through the Interactive whiteboard

Mathematics – Our maths sessions will be looking at the composition of 4 and 5 to build confidence to be able to automatically recall numbers bonds of 4 and 5. We will also begin to write and draw our mathematical thinking as well as revisit mass, capacity and time.

Understanding of the world – We begin the year exploring winter and animals that hibernate. Then in our dinosaur topic the children will be able to share their knowledge of dinosaurs before we talk about fossils and how they might have become extinct. We will also celebrate Chinese New Year in the class where the children will learn about the cus some Chinese food.

Art and design –. During our dinosaur topic the children will create 3D models using junk materials learning to select the right materials as well as the best ways to join them. We will look at colour mixing and how to create texture.

Physical Development – In our twice weekly PE sessions we will continue to develop our co-ordination, strength and balance as well as learning to control a ball using hands and feet.

How you can help your child at home:


Please continue to access digital books through Oxford Owl. This will build up your child's confidence to use phonic sounds to read.
