



Our topic this half-term is: "Blast off!"

In **Literacy**, we are using texts, which focus on developing the children's key literacy skills. We will be using 'Man on the moon: a day in the life of Bob, The Darkest Dark and Curiosity: the story of a mars rover as a stimulus for drama and writing.

In **Mathematics**, we are focussing on place-value, reading, writing, counting, representing numbers, comparing and ordering numbers to 10/20.

In Science, we will be using our senses to explore the signs of autumn and discussing different materials.

In **PE.** our focus is gymnastics and we will be using balance and movement to form routines. In outdoor PE we are developing our Multi-skills; balancing, throwing and co-ordination.

In **History**, we will be looking at the lunar landing when Neil Armstrong landed on the moon and comparing this to Tim Peake.

In **DT**, we are going to design and build a rocket ship and space vehicle for Bob, the man on the moon.

In ICT, we are learning about Internet safety and how to log on to Purple mash (more information to follow).

Our focus value will be belonging and our learning characters, Team Ant and Kind Koala.



How you can help your child at home:

We encourage you to speak to any member of the team to share your celebrations and concerns. If you need to speak to the teachers we are happy to meet you, but you will need to arrange this via the school office.

**Reading:** Share books with your child, using the weekly focus in their diaries. Please sign their diaries to show what reading they have been doing, we enjoy reading your comments and responding to them.

Spelling/Phonics: Keep practising all of the Floppy phonic sounds learnt so far as we will initially be revisiting them and then moving on to the next set of sounds.

Maths: Please help your child to practise writing the numbers 0 to 10 then extend to 20, and counting groups of objects using household items beyond 20.

We will send you weekly updates about what we are focussing on each week via Tapestry.
