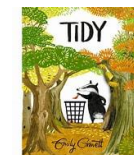

Moving on to the Junior School

We try to make this as positive an experience as we possibly can as we know it will cause lots of anxiety at this point of the year. Here are some of the events we have planned that you can talk about with your child, to reinforce positivity.

- Swimming at the Junior School – we are so lucky that they have a heated pool that we are invited to use. Whilst there, your child will use the field, playground and activity trail so they will become familiar with the grounds. The Junior School children also have their playtime whilst we are there, so this is a great opportunity to rekindle friendships with older Alverstoke Infant children that they may have played with previously. They also get to meet new friends because the older children are so curious and nurturing of our youngsters.
- The Buddy System- your child will be buddied with a Year 5 child who will become their 'go to friend' when they are at the Junior School, now but more importantly, when they are Year 3.
- Parent Picnic - you will be invited to the Junior School to meet their buddy.
- Meeting their new teacher at the Infant School – their new teacher will come to us and spend time observing, talking to and getting to know your children. There will also be a meeting for you to hear from Mrs Slowther.
- Spending two days at the Junior School- two days where we meet them at the Junior School and teach alongside their new teacher. We will showcase their work at the end of the second day in an open classroom display.
- All Infant school staff speak to the Junior school staff and disseminate achievements, gaps in learning, SEN records etc. so that the Junior school staff are completely prepared in September.
